### C.D. Howe Building, Ottawa, Ontario

This Federal Government office building includes the office of the Auditor General and other smaller tenants. The lower levels of the building contain a shopping mall called 240 Sparks.

### Jackson Building, Ottawa, Ontario

This project consisted of 200,000 to 270,000 square feet of renovations to relocate Elections Canada.

### Laurier Building, Ottawa, Ontario

This project involved a complete base building and tenant renovation for the Solicitor General and Correctional Services Canada.

### Mississauga Civic Centre, Mississauga, Ontario

This 280,000 square foot municipal administration complex includes council chambers, assembly and public space, offices, computer facilities, an art gallery, a cafeteria and a winter garden. Landscape features include a reflecting pool/fountain, an artificial ice rink and a parking garage.

### Pickering City Hall, Pickering, Ontario

This facility includes a council chamber, meeting rooms, an office area, a cafeteria, a library, a separate stand alone computer room facility and specialty areas. Heating, ventilating, air conditioning, plumbing and drainage, fire protection and heating scheduled hot water with perimeter radiation.

### Ottawa City Hall, Ottawa, Ontario

The construction of the new 699,700 square foot administrative office building housing Municipal Government Departments Council includes two levels of underground parking, meeting rooms and an adjoining heritage normal school building for additional administration space.

### Regional Municipality of Waterloo Administration Building, Waterloo, Ontario

This central facility housing the Regional Government offices includes a nine-storey office building, council chambers, cafeteria, and a two-storey underground parking storage. TMP provided the complete mechanical engineering services for this municipal office space and council chambers.

### Toronto Old City Hall, Toronto, Ontario

A unique interior renovation of a heritage building to accommodate 2,400 square feet of new office space inside the existing attic. This building includes the offices of the Ministry of Attorney General and Justice of the Peace. The HVAC system was developed as a standalone VAV unit with integral cooling to approach M.A.G. standards. Heating systems were developed from base building capacity.

### Tupper Building, Ottawa, Ontario

This project included 100,000 square feet of selected base building and tenant renovations.

### Supreme Court, Ottawa, Ontario

This project involved renovations to the Parliament Building and Senate Library.
