Art Gallery of Ontario

Representative projects include a new café, a special gallery for the exhibition of a single reliquary artifact, renovation of the cooling system for the special/touring exhibits gallery, a gallery-wide humidification study, boiler and chiller plant studies.

Canadian Museum for Human Rights

This 240,000 square foot museum includes permanent and temporary galleries, a 350 seat auditorium, restaurant, administrative offices and collection storage facilities. The building is to be designed to achieve LEED certification. Sustainable design features include radiant cooling/heating displacement ventilation, double-curtain wall with dynamic buffer zone and low water consumption fixtures.

Canadian War Museum

The Canadian War Museum is a 440,000 square foot landmark facility with a “green building” mandate. The new facility will feature greatly expanded exhibition space, a gallery for Canada’s magnificent collection of war art, classrooms for various workshops and the teaching of different aspects of Canada’s military history, a theatre for performances, major speaking engagements and films, research and library facilities and climate-controlled storage space.

Ismaili Centre

The Ismaili Centre is an 80,000 square foot two-story building housing a Prayer Hall, entrance foyers and cloakrooms, social hall, library, meeting rooms, administrative offices, main council chamber room, associated facilities such as washrooms, kitchens, etc. and a two level underground parking garage with a capacity of approximately 300 parking spaces.

Renaissance ROM

New exhibit building plus extensive renovations to galleries and back of house within the existing building. While the new “crystal” building provides a modern accent, the renovation to the existing building will preserve its heritage characteristics while enhancing the building envelope performance and its interior services. New construction totaled 174,000 square feet and the renovation totaled 200,000 square feet.

Transformation AGO

TMP will provide full commissioning services for the Transformation AGO project, which is a 190,000 square foot renovation and 97,000 square foot addition to the Art Gallery of Ontario. It will integrate many ways in which people and art can connect. It includes a two level gift and book shop, a restaurant, a café, a lecture theatre, a member’s lounge and a free contemporary art space for new projects by upcoming artists.
